There is an ordinance on the books and he is having the solicitor review something. If we enforce a time with one park; we have to enforce it with the others also. We might possibly be able to place a camera there. There is a plan in the works.

GENERAL BUSINESS

Engineer Sites stated that he spoke to the DEP about placing a structure in the creek at McLaughlin Run to catch some of the heavy debris. The DEP stated that we cannot be putting structures into the stream. He stated that he had a meeting with Kelly McLaughlin from the Allegheny County Conservation District and she said that there is already one in place in Shaler on Pike Creek. He went to North Hills on Route 8 and found large pipe ballards that were placed in Pine Creek with the intention of catching the large debris and trees while allowing the water to go through it. It looks like they have drilled the pipe ballards into the creek bed and offset them enough to catch something large that would be coming down Pine Creek. When he talked to Kelly, she stated that she obtained a permit through the DEP to do this. He is going to investigate this further.
