ROLL CALL

M. Tolmer stated that there are 3 particular road improvements in Bridgeville that were discussed in our informational meeting this evening. One is Chartiers Street from Washington Avenue to Werner Avenue. We are looking to make that three lanes. One lane going into Bridgeville up the hill and 2 lanes going out onto the bridge to improve traffic conditions and give us a stacking lane. The second is the alignment of Lesnett Road, Mayview Road, Bank Street and Chartiers Street. The third is the restriping of Washington Avenue from the Post Office to Rite Aid.

Mr. Palluch stated that he really likes the idea of the signs going up in Bridgeville letting people know where everything is. It will look nice.

Manager Collins stated that they are in the process of setting up a kick-off meeting with the signage company.

Mr. Palluch also asked when the paving will begin on Baldwin Street.

Engineer Sites stated that Insight Pipe just received notification to go ahead and make the repairs to the sanitary sewer and adjust the manholes, then we can get Youngblood Paving to start. It should begin in 3 or 4 weeks.

Mr. Palluch also question not being able to build in a flood zone.

Paul & Vickie Meurer – 1435 Missouri Avenue
Bridgeville, PA 15017

Mrs. Meurer stated that across the street at 1426 Missouri Avenue, there is a vent pipe. There is a new owner that has been working on the house the last couple of weeks. His wife and he came over to introduce themselves and he said that the first thing he was going to do was to take down the vent pipe. That should not be taken down because that is the vent for the gas well. She stated that she called Don Delach in Florida and he said Mr. Wessel who built the house told him to never take that down because it could be very dangerous. The smell is unbelievable. She asked who can she call or what can they do?

Manager Collins stated that our Building Inspector, Engineer Sites and she will meet there tomorrow morning.


GENERAL BUSINESS
